1. Approval of Previous Minutes: By vote as amended. (Changes in name spelling)

2. Reports:

i. Rector's Report (Vicki)

- a. There is no update on Michael Murray's funeral arrangements. Vicki will meet next week to get the arrangements underway.
- b. Thanks for participating in the Capital campaign first impression gathering. The parish survey will come after the stewardship campaign. After that we will get the results of the feasibility study.
- c. There have been issues with Wi-fi. Every wi-fi switch in the complex had to be manually reset to get through the firewall. Then the problem could be diagnosed, and the solution found. It is 90% fixed but there's still some clean-up to be done.
- d. Starting yesterday afternoon there have been problems with the phones. Some connect but some do not. There will be a service call soon to rectify the problem.
- e. 150 people came through the senior-palooza. UA was very pleased. The commission on aging will make a donation to St. Mark's for the use of the space.
- f. We are a sponsor of the Tremont school. Friday is the Tremont School Fall Festival. They need help at 3:30 to set up carnival games from anyone who can help.
- g. Bishop White is coming in May 18th for visitation and Confirmation. It is also the day of the canterbury choir evensong. The Bishop has been invited to stay for the evensong.
- h. Nov 22 and 23 is the Diocesan Convention. We have 4 representatives going, Cheryl, Kevin, Michael and Barb.
- i. The rector and wardens of St. Patrick's have been meeting with us about how to reach the exploding new population of our central Ohio area. It is 19 zip codes. Vicki pulled up all new sign-ups for utilities. In 60 days, there were 6,200 households. The plan is to do a combo of direct mail (Christmas, Easter, and Fall,) with social media advertising. We would expect 1% response rate. The budget for three sets of direct mails would be \$30,000. They pitched the Bishop for \$25,000 in support. She has not said "No." This is a pilot project, and it is completely replicable.
 - i. The churches will do the Christmas push whether they get Diocesan funding or not. We should know relatively soon whether or not we will get diocesan help.

ii. Senior Warden's Report (Cheryl)

a. Cheryl has received no emails

iii. Junior Warden's Report (Kevin)

- a. We had a successful workday in September. Thanks to those who helped. Mostly cleaning and cosmetic stuff.
- b. We are expecting a bill of about \$2,000 for the work done to repair the network and Wifi issues.
- c. Update on doors. By the end of October the panic bars on the patio will be installed. The other doors will be done in November.

iv. Treasurer's Report (Phil)

a. Referred to statement in packet. It is a month old. We are in pretty good shape. September statement will be done soon. We budgeted a 34,000 deficit; we are currently \$39,000 in the black.
